

Ringling Hotel Man Dies Monday

Funeral services were held Wednesday at 10 a.m. in the Ringling Church of Christ for Howard E. Brian, 70, widely known Ringling hotel operator, who died in Ringling, Aug. 22nd. Roy Hannah, minister in the Shell Street Church of Christ in Healdton, conducted the service, with burial at Dixie, under the direction of Collier Funeral Home.

The deceased was born at Waverly, Ill., March 16, 1890, and died Aug. 22, 1960, at the age of 70 years, five months and six days.

He was married to Pauline Engle, Aug. 28, 1929 at Tulsa. He had been a member of the American Legion for 42 years and was a World War I veteran. He and his wife had operated a hotel in Ringling for many years and he was highly esteemed by all who knew him. He and his wife were also well known here.

Surviving are his wife, Pauline, of the home address in Ringling; one sister, Jessie Brina; and a number of nephews and nieces.
